

Why Porsche.

With over 70 years of racing history and more than 32,000 victories to date, Porsche is the leading manufacturer in the world to specialize in high-performance cars and the most successful marque in motorsports. We are incredibly passionate about this and uphold and entire philosophy underpinning Porsche Motorsport: Spirit. Principle. Vision.

We are proud of our ability to use past lessons and tradition as a source of inspiration for creating future innovation and constantly breathing life into 'fascination sports car'. We never rest on the winner's podium but look ahead to the next challenge and this year that includes a focus on continuing the racing activities of the Porsche family in the winter season.

With a record number of overall victories, Porsche is the most successful manufacturer in Le Mans history. Our rich heritage and pioneering technologies were pivotal in the three consecutive wins in 2015, 2016 and 2017 with the 919 Hybrid. Similarly, they helped to secure 2018's Le Mans GTE-Pro championship for the former 911 RSR, with its replacement winning its FIA World Endurance Championship debut in 2019. A new era began with Porsche entering the LMDh programme. Be part of that living Porsche Motorsport history by racing in an official one-make series with a Porsche race car.

As a driver in the Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe, you are instantly climbing onto the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid. Our championship provides the ideal stepping stone to develop and ultimately graduate on the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid to high level international championships. The championship is the ideal training platform to prepare for the next steps within the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid.

Three Porsche Trophies, seventeen Porsche Sprint Challenges and eleven Porsche Carrera Cups operate worldwide, culminating with the internationally contested Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup. This is the world's fastest international one-make championship, and it tours selected rounds of the Formula 1[®] Championship. The Porsche One-Make series is one of the most successful international racing programmes and Project European Winter Season is the perfect way to further a racing career for every type of driver.

Through direct involvement in the European motorsport and together with Porsche AG we continue to raise customer awareness and interest in Porsche Motorsport throughout the Europe to unprecedented levels. No other manufacturer makes such a substantial ongoing commitment to the sport.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe is based on a two-day concept with a focus on ideal conditions to test and race during the European winter season. On top of this, an additional pre-event test day is offered on the day before the official test day. The platform is developed for teams and drivers of the European Porsche one-make series to continue their activities in the "offseason". After the inaugural season in 2023, a more extensive calendar is scheduled for the 2024 season adding one extra event on a new track. The Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe 2024 calendar now offers racing on 4 renown tracks of the Iberian Peninsula.

The geographic location of this series provides good weather conditions for testing and racing, while the timetable with +/-9,5 hours of track time divided over three days ensures maximum, but efficient, time on track. The track sessions are separated between two different divisions, The Sport Division for PRO and PRO-AM drivers in GT3 Cup cars and the Club Division for GT4's and AM drivers in 911 GT3 Cup cars. To optimize the training conditions even further, a maximum of +/-30 cars per division is permitted.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe is run as a Spanish national championship. Each division has two races at each event which makes the series is the ideal option for drivers with a national racing license to gain experience and prepare for an international racing licence. Furthermore, the separation of the two divisions in different classes depending on car type and driver level makes sure that every driver on the grid has the chance to fight for a podium spot and trophy.





Racing with Porsche in the European winter season 2024













Event Schedule.

New in 2024, an additional pre-event test day will be added to the event programme. This optional test day increases the total track time to approximately 9,5 hours at each event.

Entry.

The 'PSCSE Application for Entry' is the starting point for participations in the Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe. The competitor and driver are eligible to participate as soon as the 'PSCSE Application for Entry' has been confirmed by the series organisation and the entry fee has been paid. An entry is valid for the entire season, which means that a competitor is committed to participate at all classification rounds.

Guest Entries are subject to availability at each event of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe. However, full season entries have priority over guest entries. Guest drivers also participate in podium ceremonies and are eligible for points. The application deadline for guest entries is 2 weeks before each event.

Entry conditions.

Due to the demand for spots on the starting grid, the following application process is agreed on:

August 1st The application for entry opens.

September 1st Confirmation of entries and payments.

December 1st Closing deadline for full season entries.

The reasoning behind the division of the championship in Sport and Club Division is to achieve optimal training conditions for all participants on track. Furthermore, the separation makes speed differences on track smaller resulting in a safer environment and less incidents on track.

Each division has +/- 30 cars on the grid.

To make sure every driver has a chance to fight for a spot on the podium, the divisions are further separated in different classes depending on car models and driver level.

The Sport division has a PRO class for the fastest drivers and a PRO-AM class for fast gentlemen drivers and young drivers without or minor GT or international karting experience. The AM class in the Club division is intended for gentlemen drivers (older than 40 years) only. The GT4 class is open to younger and older drivers using ABS systems and is formed as an entry level class within the championship.

Each class will have a separate podium for each race and a championship classification.

An overall classification will be determined per division, crowning the overall PSCSE champions 2024.

Tire Regulations.

- Michelin is the official tire supplier
- Test days and free practice: no limit on new tire sets.
- Qualifying and Race: two new tire sets.
- Joker Tires: only allowed in case of tire damage.





Team Catering.

The Porsche Team Catering is available at all events of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe 2024. Within the Porsche Hospitality breakfast, lunch and dinner are offered in buffet form. The teams and drivers can choose the food to their liking. Drinks are in constant supply, and a selection of cakes and snacks are available in the afternoon.

The service times are scheduled according to the respective event schedule and announced via the team information and on the information board in the hospitality. With each entered car, the driver receives three catering packages included in the entry fee. Additional catering packages can be ordered up to one week before the event.

Porsche Technical Support.

The Prospeed Competition technical staff is happy to assist you with any questions you may have about your Porsche race car and additional technology (data recording, etc.) of Porsche AG at our workspace and at the circuits.

The service at the race track is integral part of the championship formula and adds further to the optimal testing and racing conditions for all drivers and teams on side. If you have any further questions regarding any technical or logistical issues, please contact the series organisation.

Spare Parts Service.

The Prospeed Competition truck travels to each round of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Southern Europe 2024 and provides an extensive spare part service for all running race cars. The parts manager on location provides a professional service to all teams in order to ensure a quick return to the track after an incident.
